A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Dr Himanshu Ghadiali, a medically qualified member of the Mental Health Jurisdiction of the Health, Education and Social Care Chamber was the subject of a General Medical Council Fitness to Practice Panel. As a result of the findings of the Fitness to Practice Panel and his removal from the General Medical Council list, the Lord Chief Justice and Lord Chancellor consider Dr Ghadiali's role as untenable and have removed him from judicial office.”
