STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

Mr. Michael Marlow

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have removed Mr. Michael Marlow from his post as a Fee-Paid Judge on the First-Tier Health, Education and Social Care Chamber, Mental Health Jurisdiction.

Mr. Marlow was convicted of driving after consuming excess alcohol and, in addition, failed in his obligation to inform the President of the Tribunal of the ongoing proceedings. Each of these matters in themselves amounts to misbehaviour and the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have agreed that Mr. Marlow has fallen short of the conduct to be expected of all judicial office holders.”
