A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

"Following a complaint about His Honour Judge Douglas John Field's demeanour during court proceedings, the Office for Judicial Complaints investigated the matter in accordance with the Judicial Discipline (Prescribed Procedures) Regulations 2006 (as amended). That investigation concluded that the complaint against His Honour Judge Field should be dismissed. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have considered the conclusions of the investigation and agreed with them. "
