STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

MISS JANE QUAYLE

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Miss Quayle, a magistrate appointed to the Leeds Bench in 2006, has failed since 2009 to achieve the minimum number of sittings expected of a magistrate. As a result, the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor have removed Miss Quayle from office.”
