## STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

### **A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:**

“Mr Colin Mallinson, a magistrate appointed to the Batley and Dewsbury Bench, has resigned after a conduct investigation found he claimed falsely for loss of earnings and travel and subsistence, while undertaking magisterial duties between November 2005 and June 2010. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice had indicated their intention to remove Mr Mallinson from the magistracy but following his resignation, no further disciplinary action is required.”
