A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Mr Mohammed Kamal, a magistrate appointed to the East Dorset bench, was involved in a business which became the subject of an investigation by the UK Border Agency. A Conduct Investigation Panel was convened and found that he had failed to inform the Advisory Committee of this matter and had brought the magistracy into disrepute. The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have removed Mr Kamal from the magistracy.”
