A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Mr Paul Robson, a magistrate appointed to the Teesside Bench failed to complete the minimum number of sittings required of a magistrate. He had also failed to keep in contact with the local Authority Committee. As a result the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor have agreed that Mr Robson has shown insufficient commitment to the magistracy and have removed him from office.”
