A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Mrs Gulshan Khan-Malik, a magistrate appointed to the Bradford bench, failed to adhere to the terms and conditions of her appointment by not meeting the minimum required sittings since 1 April 2009. In the circumstances, the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have removed Mrs Khan-Malik from the magistracy.”
