STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

MRS JACQUELINE CLARK

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

"A conduct Investigation Panel found that, in failing to maintain contact with the bench and properly discharge her duties, Mrs Clark, a JP on the Sussex (Eastern) Bench, has not demonstrated the required level of commitment required of a magistrate. As a result, the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have decided to remove Mrs Clark from the magistracy."
