A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Mrs Danielle Shattell, a magistrate appointed to the Bromley Bench, did not complete the training necessary to enable her to undertake her duties as a magistrate, and failed to keep contact with the court. As a result the Lord Chief Justice and Lord Chancellor have agreed that she should be removed from the magistracy.”
