## STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

### MS NASSIMA MARREF

#### **A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:**

“Ms Nassima Marref, a magistrate appointed to the Haringey Bench, failed to keep in sufficient contact with the local Advisory Committee to the extent she has neglected to meet her duties as a Justice of the Peace. As a result, the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor have agreed that Ms Marref has shown insufficient commitment to the magistracy and have removed her from office”.
