“The Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have removed Mrs Susan Elliott-Jones from her position as a Disability Member of the Social Entitlement Chamber. This follows her conviction for failing to notify the Secretary of State for Work and Pensions of a change in her circumstances which would affect her entitlement to claim disability living allowance.”
