A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

“Ms Andrea Campbell, a magistrate appointed to the Brent bench, failed to adhere to the terms and conditions of her appointment by not informing her Advisory Committee of impending court proceedings, and failed to provide honest answers when applying to become a magistrate. In the circumstances the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have removed Ms Campbell from the magistracy.”
