## **STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS**

### **MR WILLIAM SHELTON**

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

"Mr William Shelton, a non-legal member of the Employment Tribunal, claimed loss of earnings when he was also being paid by his employer. Given these circumstances the Lord Chancellor and the Lord Chief Justice have agreed that Mr Shelton should be removed as a member of the Employment Tribunal. "
