STATEMENT FROM THE OFFICE FOR JUDICIAL COMPLAINTS

PROFESSOR ROSHAN DOUG

A spokesperson for the Office for Judicial Complaints said:

"Professor Roshan Doug, a magistrate appointed to the Birmingham Bench, has failed to complete the minimum required sittings, or the necessary training to enable him to continue as a magistrate. He has also failed to keep in contact with his bench. As a result, the Lord Chief Justice and the Lord Chancellor have agreed that Professor Doug should be removed from the magistracy."
