“Mrs Nadine Radford QC, a recorder for the South East Circuit, has resigned from judicial office following a conduct investigation into her conviction of driving with excess alcohol in a public place. The Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice had indicated their intention to remove Mrs Radford from judicial office. Following her resignation, the Lord Chancellor and Lord Chief Justice have indicated that no further action is required.”
